Mayor Gavin Newsom spoke at the Hunters View Phase IA groundbreaking event on Wednesday, April 7. Other speakers included SF Redevelopment Agency

Executive Director Fred Blackwell, SF Supervisor Sophie Maxwell, SFHA Commission Vice President Neola Gans, HVTA President Tessie Ester, and JSCo. President & CEO Jack Gardner. Speakers celebrated this important milestone.

### **Youth Engagement**

We are happy to announce that four Hunters View youth leaders that have been accepted into the HOPE SF internship program!

Over the next few months, these outstanding new leaders will learn about planning and the development process, and then provide input on the programming for the

new Phase IA park. In June, these youth will attend a two-day conference at UC Berkeley and present their work to colleagues, professors, and community members.

### **Project Description**

The revitalization of Hunters View will result in a mixed-income community of up to 800 new residential units, with one-for-one replacement of the existing 267 public housing units. Phase IA consists of 107 affordable housing units, new infrastructure, community space, and a new park.

## Construction Update

### **Phase IA Schedule**

*Through Early May 2010:*  
Abatement & Demo of Phase I Buildings.

*Fall 2010:* Demolition of Roads, Grading and Infrastructure Work Begins

*Late 2010:* Construction of Buildings Begins

*2012:* Phase I Infrastructure and Buildings Complete.

### **Abatement Complete**

Abatement of all buildings is complete, meaning that all hazardous materials have been stabilized or removed and disposed of properly.



### **Demolition Underway**

10 buildings have been demolished, with 8 remaining. Stringent dust control measures are ensuring your safety throughout the demolition process.

Work will only take place from 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM on weekdays. On special occa-
