## Project Info & Update

## Construction Update

### Phase IA Schedule

**August 2010:** Utility back-tie work in Phase I area begins

**October 2010:** Demolition of Roads, Grading and Infrastructure Work Begins (depends on access to state funds)

**December 2010:** Construction of Buildings Begins

**2012:** Phase I Infrastructure and Buildings Complete.

### What's happening on-site?

Since demolition, the site has been inactive and monitored by 24-hour security.

Starting in late August, some of the utilities will be re-routed in preparation for site demolition. This "back-tie work" will ensure that utility service will continue in the Phases II and III areas regardless of construction work on-site.

This work will be followed by site demolition; the start date will depend on the access to

already-secured state funding.

### Phase IA Progress

Here are some exciting recent milestones reached in July 2010:

- Bond financing and tax credit applications submitted
- Infrastructure bids received from sub contractors
- Summer of Unity event held on July 17 at HV
- SF Housing Authority Commission approved the Development Agreement for the Phase I Area
